We chose them because we wanted to show them that even if you don't have much, you can still do something to make your life better.

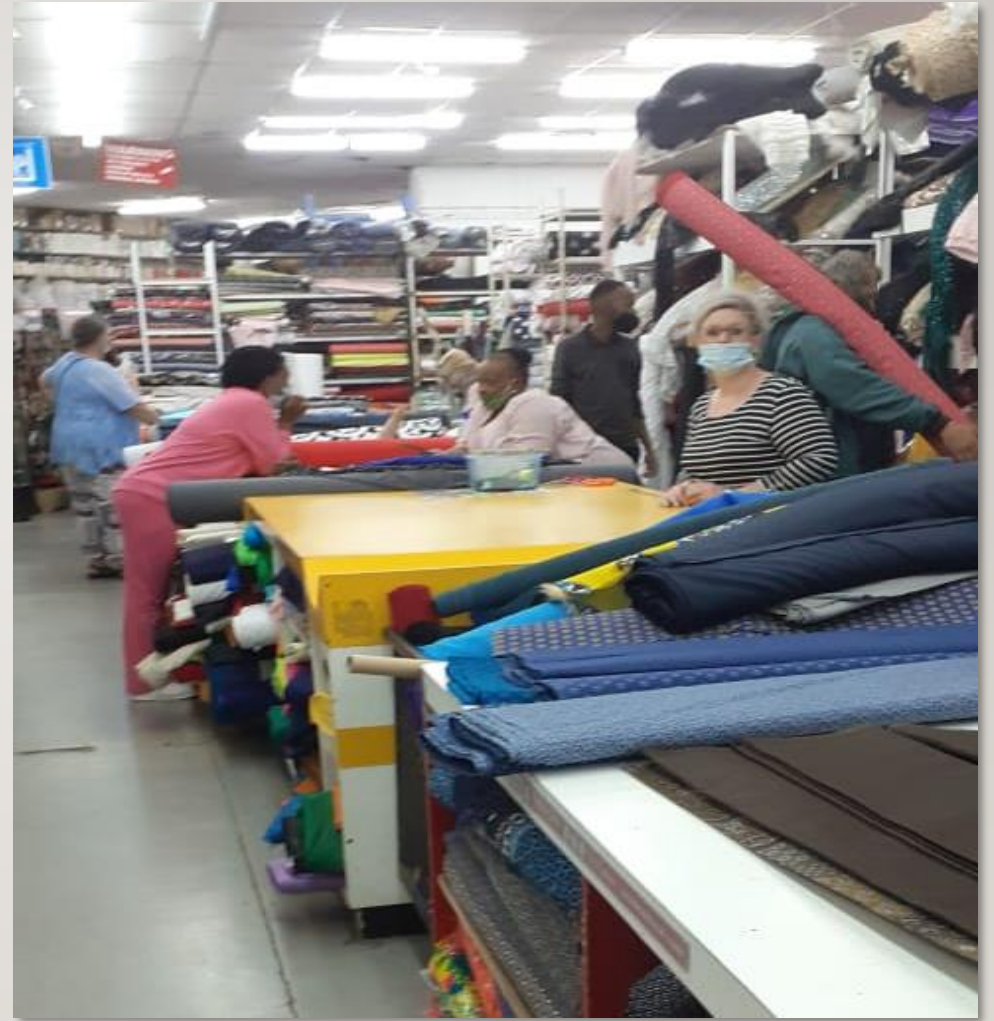

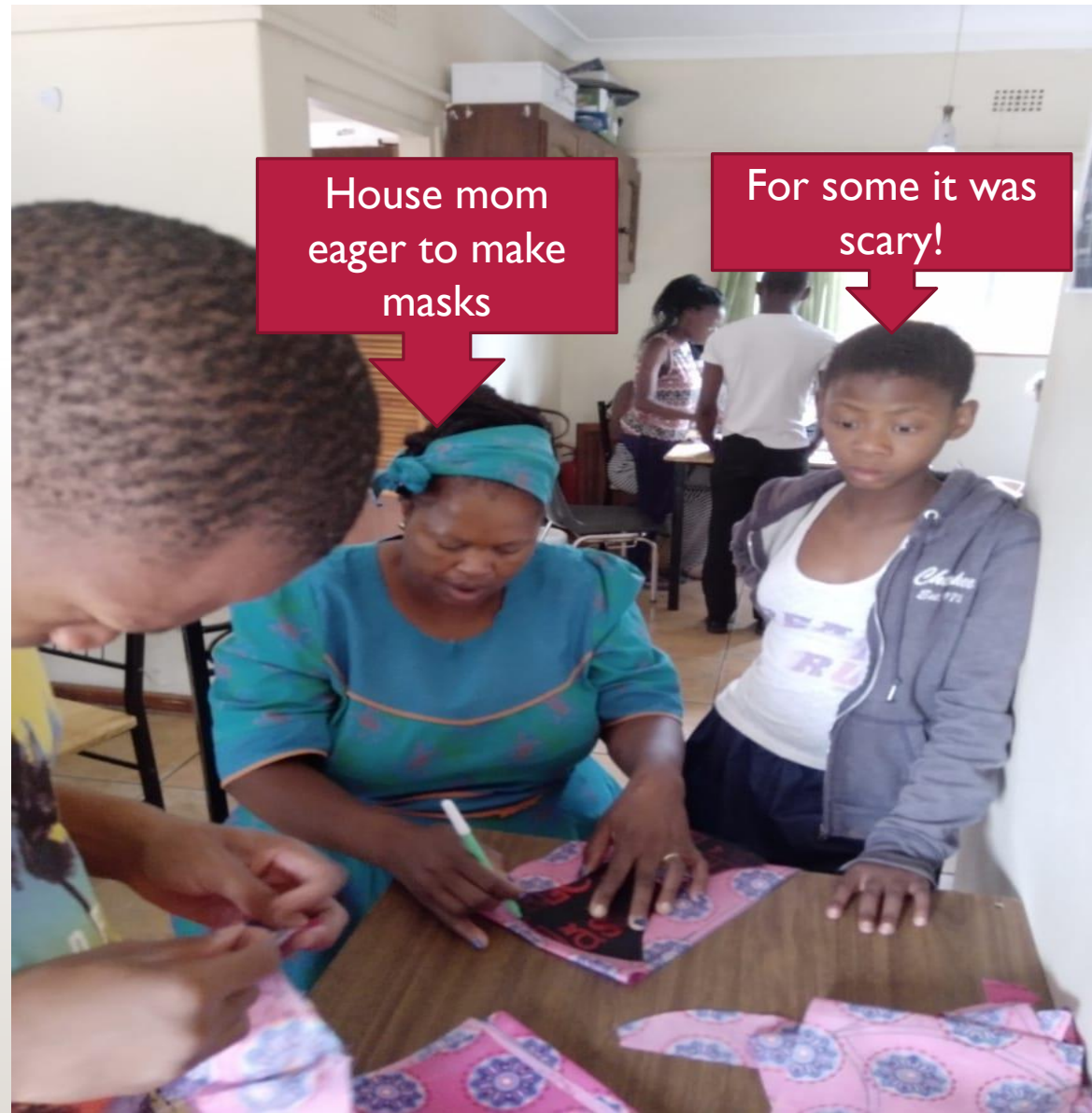

Out of the material we bought we cut out 70 masks.

If they sell the masks for R20 each $(R20 \times 70) = R1400.00$

<u>1.</u>	<u>R1400.00</u>	
Material	R400.00	(± 100 masks) Buy new material to make more masks – this time they don't have
Each child R50 each $(R50 \times 15)$	R750.00	buy needles, pins etc. so they can buy more material and elastic to
Savings / for house	R250.00	make the masks.

When we finished the project, they have already sold 40 masks.

Prediction: Next bunch: 100 masks @ R20 each = R2000

<u>2. Prediction: (100 masks x R20)</u>	<u>R2000.00</u>	
Material	R500.00	(± 125 masks)
Each child R50 each $(R50 \times 15)$	R750.00	
Savings / for house	R750.00	

Savings/for house: $R250 + R750 = R1000$ - They can reach this in one month



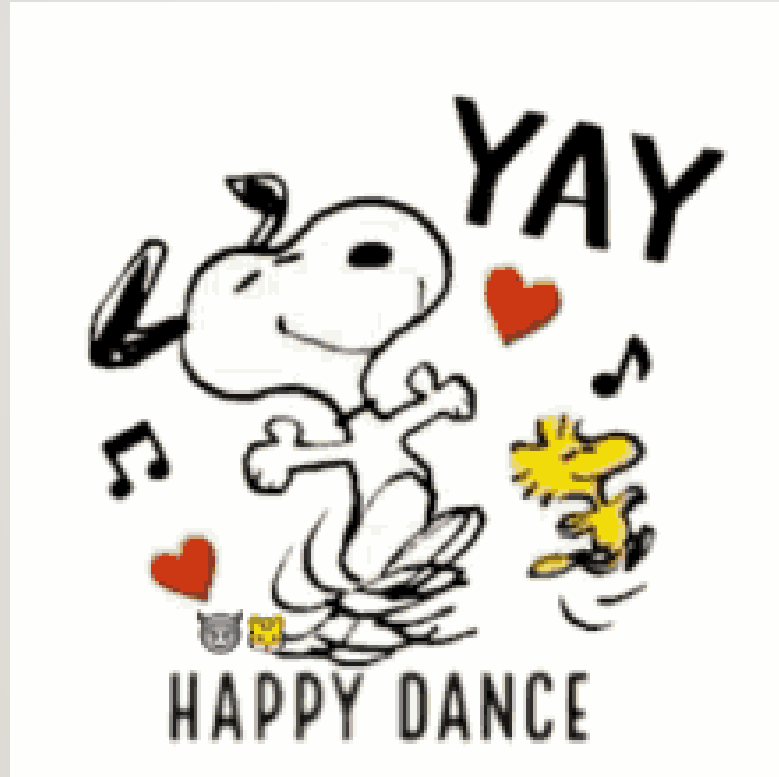
In future: The Children will also be able to make other things like pencil cases, aprons, bags and clothing
